### A Message from Kish Rajan, CEO

As a father of three Gen Z kids, I've watched them grow up deeply aware of climate change and motivated to make a difference. Their passion for sustainability inspires me every day in my role at Mt. Diablo Resource Recovery (MDRR). It's what drives our commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions, giving new life to reclaimed materials, and keeping as much as possible out of landfills. Plus, it just makes good business sense.



Every day, our team proves that we can maximize recycling and diversion, make the cities we serve cleaner and more sustainable, and strengthen our company at the same time. Waste management today isn't just about emptying garbage bins and carting waste to the landfill — it's about innovation and helping our customers reach their environmental quality goals.

Recycling and composting are key components of that diversion. Each year, MDRR collects and manages 160 million pounds of recyclables and 120 million pounds of organic waste, while also helping customers understand how to use these programs effectively.

But we don't stop there. Ten years ago, we partnered with RecycleSmart (Central Contra Costa Solid Waste Authority) to collect reusable items and find them new homes. At our Pittsburg warehouse, curbside-collected reusables are sorted and distributed through dozens of community organizations to families in need. Over the years, this has meant redistributing student desks to local schools and furnishing homes for those previously unhoused or aging out of foster care.

## TIPS FOR CURBSIDE CONTAINER PLACEMENT

- Place carts curbside by 5 am the day of service or the night before. Space carts 3 feet apart from one another.
- Do not overload carts; lids must be closed. For extra service please contact us for pickup options.
- Do not place carts near basketball hoops, cars, trees, or low-hanging wires. Our trucks cannot service carts when they are near these objects.
- Please remove carts from the curb within 24 hours of collection.

## WEEKLY CURBSIDE COLLECTION SERVICE:



### ORGANICS

The organics material collected by our trucks is taken to a compost facility and turned into enriched soil.

**ACCEPTED MATERIALS:** Meat • Fish • Poultry • Bones • Fruits • Vegetables • Grains • Plate Scrapings • Food-Soiled Paper • Leaves • Grass Clippings • Plant + Garden Trimmings • Weeds • Branches + Twigs (no more than 3-inch diameter and 3 feet long)



Dirt • Sod • Palm Fronds • Rock • Concrete • Pet Waste • BPI Certified Products • Bioplastics • Hazardous Materials



### RECYCLABLES

Please only place acceptable, clean, empty, and dry items loosely in the recycling container.

**ACCEPTED MATERIALS:** Plastics #1 PET + #2 HDPE • Bottles • Jars • Tin • Cans • Cereal + Snack Boxes • Cardboard • Clean Paper



Food-Contaminated Containers • Plastic Film • Foam Products • Textiles • E-Waste • Batteries • Hazardous Materials



### GARBAGE

Bag items that are no longer usable and place them in the garbage container. Donate items that are in good condition.



Recyclables • Yard + Food Waste • Fluorescent Bulbs • E-Waste • Batteries • Hazardous Materials

## BEYOND THE CART

Pittsburg residential customers with active service can contact MDRR for the following curbside services at no additional charge:



**Two On-Call Pickups:** Each calendar year we will collect up to twelve 32-gallon bags of household garbage or yard waste weighing no more than 50 pounds apiece. If you have branches, tie them in a bundle no larger than 18" x 3'. On-call pickups must be at least one week apart.



**Bulky Item Pickup:** When you call to schedule one of your On-Call Pickups, you can now include ONE bulky item per calendar year. Which may be an appliance, electronic, or a piece of furniture.



**On-Call Scrap Metal Pickup:** You can schedule a curbside pickup of small metal scrap and cast aluminum items once a year.



**Household Battery Pickups:** Schedule to have your household batteries picked up. Place batteries in a clear, sealed bag labeled "batteries" and set next to your garbage cart. Auto batteries must go to the HHW Facility.



**CFL Pickups:** Schedule in advance for CFL (compact fluorescent lightbulb) pickup. Place CFL bulbs in a clear, sealed bag labeled "lights" and set curbside. CFLs larger than 3 ft. must go to the HHW Facility.



**Used Motor Oil + Filter Pickups:** Please contact our office to request a motor oil recycling kit. We will provide a free 6-quart oil container and sleeve. Once received and filled, contact us, and we'll schedule a pickup.

We're also growing our Back-to-School project to provide at least 500 fully stocked backpacks to local children in need.

I'm proud of how far we've come and excited for what's ahead.

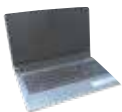

Household items containing corrosive, toxic, or flammable ingredients are considered Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). Never put these products down the drain or in your carts. Dispose of fat, oil, and grease (FOG) with HHW products. **Take HHW including sharps + medications to Delta Diablo** at 2550 Pittsburg-Antioch Hwy in Pittsburg. Disposal is free. ## Free Christmas Tree Recycling

There are 2 easy ways to recycle your Christmas tree:

**AT THE CURB:** Scheduled in advance, Christmas trees will be picked up curbside at no additional charge. Trees longer than 3 feet must be cut into 3-foot sections before placing the pieces inside or next to your organics cart. Pieces larger than 3 feet cannot fit inside the truck.

**DROP OFF:** Bring your **full-size tree (no need to cut it)** to our 1300 Loveridge Road Facility in Pittsburg. Christmas trees will be taken at no charge — limit one tree per vehicle. See below for our facility hours.

**NOTE:** Remove all tinsel, ornaments, lights, and tree stands. Flocked trees cannot be recycled and must be disposed of as garbage — consider using an artificial flocked tree that can be reused year after year.

We accept solid waste, organics, yard waste, wood, plastics, metals, cardboard, building material, dirt, rock, concrete, electronics, appliances, and more.
