

We're Picking Up

Mt. Diablo Resource Recovery is your one-stop shop for organics, recycling, and solid waste collection services. We use an approach called Community Resource Optimization to reduce our carbon footprint and increase the value of the material we collect and process.

COLLECTION SERVICE

Garbage, recyclables, and organics are collected weekly on your regularly scheduled day. The monthly rate is based on garbage cart size, available in 64- and 96-gallons. For pricing, please visit www.mdrr.com.

CART PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

Place all carts curbside by 5 AM on the day of service. Carts must have at least 3ft of space between them and other objects, such as cars, trees, and basketball hoops.



Place carts curbside no more than 12 hours before your scheduled pickup and store them in a place not visible to public view no later than 8 pm the day of service. Keep all material below the container's rim with the lid closed and do not place oversized items inside your carts. Due to traffic, road conditions, and other variables, pickup times may vary on scheduled collection days. Please allow your drivers from 5 AM to 6 PM for service. Report service issues within 24 hrs. of scheduled service day.

TOO TOXIC FOR YOUR CARTS

Household items containing corrosive, toxic, or flammable ingredients are considered Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). Never put these products down the drain or in your carts. Dispose fat, oil, and grease (FOG) with HHW products. **Take HHW to Delta Diablo Sanitation** at 2550 Pittsburg-Antioch Hwy in Pittsburg. Disposal is free. Visit their website for a list of HHW items and drop-off hours: www.deltadiablo.org.

Beyond the Cart

Pittsburg residential customers with active service can contact, in advance, MDRR for the following curbside services at no additional charge:



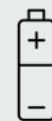
Two On-Call Pickups: Each calendar year will collect up to twelve 32-gallon bags of household garbage or yard waste weighing no more than 50 pounds apiece. If you have branches, tie them in a bundle no larger than 18" x 3'. On-call pickups must be at least one week apart.



Bulky Item Pickup: When you call to schedule one of your On-Call Pickups, you can now include ONE bulky item per year. Which may be an appliance, electronic, or a piece of furniture.



On-Call Scrap Metal Pickup: You can schedule a curbside pickup of small metal scrap and cast aluminum items once a year.



Household Battery Pickups: Schedule to have your household batteries picked up. Batteries must be in a tightly sealed container or plastic bag labeled "batteries" and must be left next to your garbage cart for removal. Automobile batteries must be taken to your local HHW Facility.



CFL Pickups: CFL (compact fluorescent lightbulbs) pickup requires contact ahead to schedule. CFLs need to be in a tightly sealed container or plastic bag labeled "lights" and need to be curbside next to your garbage cart for removal. CFLs 3ft or larger must be taken to the HHW Facility.



Used Motor Oil & Filter Pickups: Please contact our office to request a motor oil recycling kit. We will then provide a free 6-quart oil container and sleeve. Once received and filled, contact us, and we'll schedule pick up.

Billing

Residential bills are sent on the 1st of every month. Payment for service is due upon receipt. Service will be suspended if payment is not received within 2 months of the bill date. If an account is suspended, a reconnect fee will be applied. The balance must be paid in full to resume service.

GO PAPERLESS

Visit www.mdrr.com/pay-my-bill/ and choose your service area. Log in and click the HELP/FAQ button, select Bill Delivery Options, and follow the steps.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE:

Collection occurs on holidays except Christmas and New Year's Day. If your scheduled service day falls on or after one of these holidays, your collection is delayed by one day. If the holidays fall on the weekend, there will be no change in the collection schedule.

POLICIES: FAQs

Mandatory Service: Property owners of every type of real property is required to store, collect, and dispose of all refuse produced or accumulated on the premises. (PMC § 8.04.040)

Mandatory requirement to recycle: Each property owner or occupant in the City (as defined by PMC 8.04.030) is required to separate and recycle all recyclables from the solid waste generated on-premises as defined by PMC 8.04.030 (PMC § 8.06.040)

Mandatory requirement to separate organics: Property owners or occupants, (as defined by PMC 8.04.040) shall source all organic refuse from the garbage generated on-premises as defined by 8.04.040. (PMC § 8.09.040).

Collection Containers Placement: All collection containers shall be maintained in a code-compliant location and screened from public view. Additionally, containers must be removed from public view no later than 8 pm the day of service. (PMC § 8.04.080)
