We accept household garbage, recyclables, yard waste, paper, wood, plastics, metals, cardboard, construction debris and much more! We have a large 17 acre facility, that has 16 acres dedicated to recycling. Mt. Diablo Recycling Center (adjacent to the Transfer Station) is the largest recycling center in the County. It is approximately 90,000 square feet! We are dedicated to continually discovering and developing new ways to recycle and reuse.

One example of re-purposing is that when you bring tires to the Recycling Center & Transfer Station they are shredded, recycled and used for road base and playground equipment and artificial grass fields. Another example is that the carpet foam padding you drop off is recycled into new foam padding. We also give guided tours of our facility with an emphasis on education. The Recycling Center & Transfer Station **DOES NOT** accept Household Hazardous or Infectious Waste.



Many products in your home contain hazardous material. It is illegal and unsafe to throw away household hazardous waste in your garbage container, on the ground, or down a storm drain. Examples of Household Hazardous Waste:

- ✗ Fungicides
- ✗ Fuel Additives
- ✗ Cosmetics
- ✗ Carburetor Cleaner

If you have hazardous waste items, please contact your garbage company for a free drop off location.

ALL LOADS MUST BE COVERED: Per the City of Pittsburg's Municipal Code, Section 8.04.140, all vehicles transporting refuse within the City shall be completely covered to prevent spilling and blowing from a vehicle when on route to a disposal site. This is in accordance with State law, California Vehicle Code (CVC) Sections 23114 and 23115, which states it is against the law to operate a vehicle on the highway which is improperly covered, constructed, or loaded so that any part of its content or load spills, drops, leaks, blows or otherwise escapes from the vehicle. In addition, CVC 2011 states any vehicle transporting garbage, trash, or rubbish, used cans or bottles, waste papers, waste cardboard, etc. must have the load covered to prevent any part of the load from spilling on the highway. Significant fines are possible for non-compliance. Exempt materials include hay and straw, clear waste and feathers from live birds.

E-Waste such as CRTs, Printers, Computer Monitors, TVs, VCRs, and Copy Machines, are sorted and recovered – then sent to a facility where they are dismantled.

YARD WASTE COMPOST

The Recycling Center & Transfer Station accepts and recycles yard waste. The yard waste is ground up and sent to a composting facility where it gets composted. We accept Brush, Hay Ground Clippings, Leaves, Flowers, Grass, Tree Trimmings, Wood Chips, Garden Trimmings, Shrubbery, House Plants, Twigs & Branches.
